Project Design

The Mt. Milligan Project design meets or exceeds regulatory requirements and industry best practices. Impacts to water resources are limited to small streams that provide marginal or lower-quality fish habitat.

Terrane will fully compensate for all fish habitat losses by creating permanent, high quality habitat for rainbow trout elsewhere in the Rainbow Creek watershed. Compensation works will result in a net increase of available fish habitat within the watershed.

Progressive environmental approaches are integrated into each stage of the Project. The Tailings Storage Facility (TSF) and plant site are now located immediately adjacent to the open pit. Waste rock dumps were eliminated by incorporating waste rock into the TSF, and existing logging roads and right-of-ways were employed for access wherever possible to minimize clearing.

Highlights

- A bond for the full cost of closure will be provided to the BC Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources prior to mine operations.
- Compact, efficient design minimizes potential impacts on fish and water resources.
- The Project will not use a lake for tailings storage.
- Zero surface water discharge during construction and operations.
- A robust, comprehensive closure plan. The Tailings Storage Facility will be fully reclaimed when the mine is closed.
- Terrane received a Certificate under the BC Environmental Assessment Act in March 2009.
